Dear Year 9 Parents and Carers,

Immersion Day Two – Tuesday 26th March 2019

At Shenley Academy we deliver our Citizenship and PSHE curriculum through termly Immersion Days. On these occasions all pupils do not follow their usual timetable but instead have a specially designed day of activities.

Saturn College runs the Year 9 Immersion Day, the theme of which is *Health and the World Around Us*. This will include sessions on world travel, self-esteem and healthy relationships. As your child will be participating in a range of activities, instead of their school uniform **they need to wear their Shenley PE kit.**

This means:

- Shenley polo shirt or long sleeved Shenley sports top.
- Shenley shorts (if it is cold they may wear their Shenley jogging bottoms over the top of their shorts and remove them when they get into school, or leggings can be worn with shorts worn over the top).
(Please note that this arrangement is not the same for normal physical education lessons.)
- Shenley black and red socks.
- Trainers.
- Shenley school uniform jumper and black coat if it is cold.

If your child is not in the correct Shenley Academy PE kit, as described above, they will be unable to participate in the activities.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me before the day.

Attendance on Immersion Day will also be part of the criteria for qualifying for student reward trips at the end of the year.
