School uniform from September 2020

Thank you to those who responded on the uniform consultation. While the responses were overwhelmingly positive we have made the decision that in light of the extended lockdown, where many families have suffered financial hardship through furloughing or loss of jobs, that now is not the appropriate time for families to incur additional expenses.

Therefore, we would ask that once our academy has re-opened and students are attending wearing full uniform, that any student who chooses to wear a skirt ensures that it is a **tailored knee length black skirt**. These are available from school uniform suppliers but also from local supermarkets. Please see some examples on the next page of suitable school skirts. We will keep in school a supply of suitable skirts and will ask any student who is not wearing a knee length tailored skirt to change into one of them. **Under no circumstances will lycra skirts be permitted.**

We thank you for your continued support and co-operation, and look forward to welcoming more students back to the academy over the coming months.
