Class Charts can be accessed by any device that connects to the internet including mobile devices.

Home learning will be set as a ten question quiz set up on Class Charts for your child to answer. At times your child's class teachers may add a free text box to allow your child to construct a more developed answer.

To support your child's home learning, tasks will be linked to one of the following:

- A knowledge organiser
- Reading material provided to your child within the lesson
- An online clip/reading material

Please could I politely request you encourage and support your child in completing their home learning. In school our inclusion team will run a home learning club for each year group within one of the IT rooms.
