



1. Teams - How to Login using a web browser


On any web browser, e.g. Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Safari etc, go to www.office.com






Click sign in and sign in with your full school email address. Please be mindful of spelling and capital letters.

You will be displayed with the following screen:





Click on the Teams icon





Teams - Joining a Virtual Classroom - Student

Your teacher will have sent you an invite for your live lessons. Please find these in the calendar App.




Any live Lesson will be visible on your calendar. Select your lesson

- You will need to bring this work with you when you return to academy on 23.11.20.


2. **Guidance for tablets or Mobile Phone**. A web browser function can be used. (if supported by your devise). Or you will need to first download the App.

Install the Teams Mobile App

- On your mobile device, open the <u>Google Play Store</u> or the <u>Apple App Store</u>.
- 2. Search for Microsoft Teams.



Download and install the app. (Exact steps are different on each device.)
