Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you we will be having a charity Christmas Jumper Day on **Thursday 17th December**.

Students who would like to be involved are invited to wear a Christmas style jumper in place of their normal school jumper on Thursday 17th December. **Students are expected to wear the rest of their uniform as they would normally, including school shoes.** Christmas jumpers may include a wintry pattern or an image linked to Christmas.
