Dear Parent/Carer,

I wrote to you earlier this term sharing our academy's non negotiables and I would like to say thank you for your support of these; the vast majority of students have understood and complied with them well. Please could I ask you to discuss again with your child our non-negotiables as it has a real impact on the quality of education your child receives. This is particularly important as we return back to the academy after Christmas.

Our non-negotiables across the academy are:

- No trainers to be worn in school. The footwear should be black and appropriate for school. There can be no logo on the side of the shoe. (Please note: If students arrive at school in trainers, parents will be contacted to come to school to bring in the appropriate footwear)
- Students will walk quietly on corridors at all times.
- Students will not be allowed to leave their classroom for any reason during lessons, including the toilet. (Students who have a medical need to have access to the toilet during lesson must provide a doctor's note to confirm this)
- Students should arrive punctually to lessons following break and lunch.
- Students should not make physical contact with any other student.
- Students should not throw any object.
