## Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope my letter finds you well, and I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support in the challenging times we are all currently facing. We look forward to welcoming our students back to the academy and we will be operating a phased return from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March.

The phased return is necessary for us to complete the lateral flow testing of those students where parents have consented to the testing process.

## Phased return

For those students whose parents have consented to lateral flow testing, individual letters will be issued by email with the time at which you must arrive to site on your testing day. Students will remain on site until the end of the school day.

will be eligible for the lateral flow test. These tests are intended to detect anyone who is asymptomatic and will support us as a control measure in the academy.

It is essential that anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID 19 follows the government guidance, self isolates and books a PCR test. Students with symptoms must NOT attend school. The tests we have in school are designed to detect those individuals who may carry the virus (and therefore be able to transmit to others) but who do not show any symptoms.

All students where we have received consent will have 3 lateral flow tests in school, and following this, students will be provided with lateral flow tests to administer twice a week at home.

As you will appreciate, this is a logistical challenge we have not faced before, so we thank you for your support and patience with the process. We also thank those that have already consented to the testing as this aids us in keeping our community as safe as possible.

Where a student tests positive on the lateral flow test, they will be isolated and we will ask that you collect them immediately from site. The guidance must be followed with a period of 10 days' self-isolation.

### Timings of the school day

## Face coverings and hand hygiene

Students will be expected to wear face coverings in all indoor areas where 2 metre distancing cannot be maintained, and this will include classrooms. It is essential that all students come to school with their own face covering and that they also bring a spare, where we advise this is kept in their school bag in a sealed plastic bag.

Students who are exempt from wearing a face mask will be provided with a pass, which they will be expected to carry with them at all times.

Students will be expected to sanitise their hands regularly throughout the day and this will include, but not be limited to: entry to and exit from the building, on entering and exiting a classroom and entering the dining facility. Hand sanitisation units are kept filled and are located throughout the building. All students will be expected to wash their hands with soap and water before exiting the toilet facilities.

# Uniform and standards

All students will be expected to attend the academy in full uniform and this includes appropriate footwear. All students must wear school shoes and trainers will not be permitted. Windows will be open in all classrooms to ensure that they are well ventilated and we recommend that students wear a plain T-shirt or thermal vest underneath their school shirt on days where it may be slightly colder. Coats will not be permitted at any time indoors and must be removed on entry to the academy.

### **Equipment in school**

Students will be expected to be fully equipped for learning and have a school bag which can fit A4 books. Students must have a pencil case containing the following items:

- Scientific calculator
- Protractor
- Pencil
- Rubber
- Black pen
- Blue Pen
- Red pen
- Highlighter (any colour)
- 30cm ruler

Pencil cases (including two each of pencils and black pens) are available to purchase in academy, by ordering online via Parentpay at a cost of £5.40 to include a scientific calculator, or without the calculator £1.75. Calculators are also available to purchase separately at a cost of £3.65. All these items can be ordered via Parentpay, and will then be available in academy for your child.

Replacement planners, if needed, can also be purchased by ordering/paying for these on Parentpay.
