We would like to remind parents of the procedures for home testing of students for Covid 19.

Covid 19 Home testing

It is imperative that students continue to test for Covid 19 twice a week at home:

- Testing should be done at home twice weekly, 3-5 days apart every Sunday and Wednesday evening using the home test kits provided.
- Report results online as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping us to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country. By taking a test, you are obliged to report ALL results to both the NHS and the school. Please use the following links to report ALL results:

Face coverings and hand hygiene
