Shenley Academy's Y11 transition scheme

Following on from my previous correspondence, I want to make Y11 aware of the opportunities the school are putting in place to support transition to college, sixth form and apprenticeships - we feel this is especially important given the disruption to their education during the Covid 19 pandemic.

The provision will be mostly online through Class Charts, following a programme of;

- **Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHCE)** education
- Sessions based around increasing our students' **cultural capital** - exposing students to a large variety of subject areas and arts; promoting character-building qualities that lead to creating well-rounded, global citizens
- Online modules through **FutureLearn** - this is an online programme featuring world class universities and industry experts, where students can develop hobbies, new skills and receive career-changing expertise with online courses
- CV writing skills

As well as this, we are putting in-school sessions on at the following times;

- Each Monday P5 (2-3pm) Sports, run by the Shenley Academy PE department
- Each Friday P5 (2-3pm) choice of Sports with the PE department or a lecture in the theatre (which will focus on cultural capital)
