The programme details are as follows:

- The Summer Camp will run at the school from 23/08/2021 to 27/08/2021 every weekday from approximately 9.00am - 3.00pm and will focus on Mathematics, English, Sports and Drama.

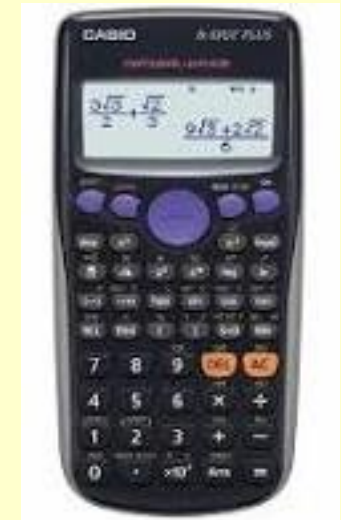

- Shenley Academy accepts NO LIABILITY should you lose or damage your phone at school.

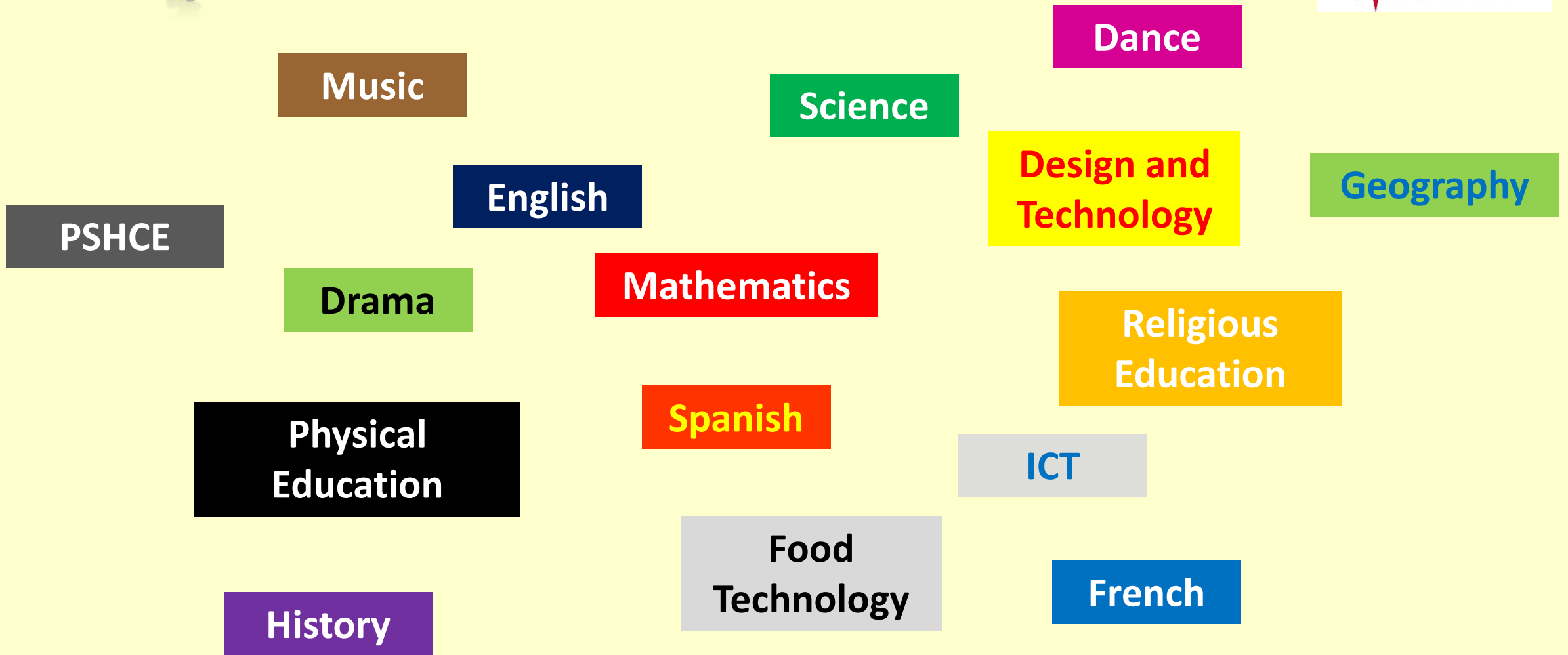

All homework is set via ***Class Charts***. Parents can access this via the academy's website. For mathematics, homework will also be set through ***Hegarty Maths***.

Class Charts is an online homework calendar. It enables students and parents to view every piece of homework which has been set by teachers at Shenley Academy. The calendar can be accessed by clicking the link at the top of the Shenley Academy homepage – no log-in is required.

Hegarty Maths is an online maths portal that contains thousands of use videos and quizzes. The Shenley Maths department use Hegarty to set homework. Your teachers will be able to mark your work and give you feedback.



If you do not have access to a computer at home then homework can be done afterschool in the library (LRC).

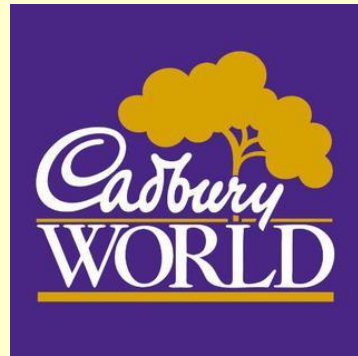
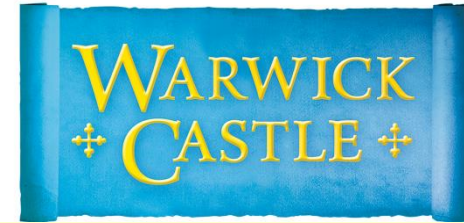

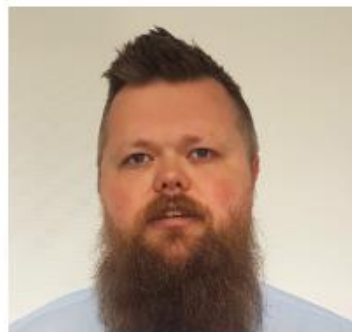
