National Strike Action

As you may be aware, teaching members of the National Education Union (NEU) have voted in favour of industrial action by their members. The next days of strike action will be on Wednesday 15^{th} March 2023 and Thursday 16^{th} March 2023

Students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 will complete learning remotely and the academy will be closed to students in these year groups. **Students in Year 11 will be expected to attend the academy as normal.**

Work for students in Years 7 to 10 will be set via ClassCharts and can be accessed via any device with internet access, including computers, tablets and smart phones.

Students all have ClassChart logins, however, all students will receive a reminder and a physical copy of their ClassCharts login on Tuesday during school time; upon logging in they will see personalised task list of work to complete. Even if your child is unable to log in, they can still see and complete the work set for each class online by going to the homework calendar on the Shenley Academy website. We would suggest checking your child is able to access this website prior to Wednesday.
