These exams are an important part of preparing your child for their GCSE Summer examinations in 2025. At Shenley Academy we want to ensure that your child is fully prepared with regards to exam expectations, exam preparation and revision alongside feedback so that in their GCSEs they are empowered in knowing what they are doing and why they are doing it.

These PPE exams will ensure that your child fully understands the formal JCQ examination regulations, and how GCSE examinations are run.
